

Codicil form

If you have already made a Will and the only change you want to make is a bequest to the National Deaf Children's Society (NDCS), you can do so by completing this codicil form.

Simply complete this form, sign it in the presence of two witnesses who should also sign the form where indicated below. The codicil should be kept with your Will.

NOTE: This codicil form contains suggested wording which we at the National Deaf Children's Society believe to be the correct form for a codicil to a Will made under the laws of England & Wales. You are advised to take independent legal advice to ensure its effectiveness as a codicil to your Will.
