

## VOLUNTEER PROFESSIONAL (AUDIOLOGY) ROLE DESCRIPTION

Volunteer professionals are an essential part of our events for **families of deaf children and young people**. We hold weekend events within the UK. You will **deliver presentations** about **your area of expertise** and **answer questions** from families who attend our Family Programme events. You therefore need to be **experienced, knowledgeable and engaging!**

### About you

- Qualified Audiologist (or similar role) with postgraduate qualification or equivalent
- Regularly work with a paediatric caseload
- Willing to speak to families of deaf children and young people about their deaf child's hearing
- Prepared to answer questions from families about their deaf child's hearing using your professional expertise
- Willing to travel within the UK

### What you will do

- Deliver pre-prepared presentations effectively
- Answer questions that families may have using your professional expertise or signpost where appropriate
- Adapt your presentation delivery and facilitation styles to meet the needs of families
- Create an open and supportive environment where families feel comfortable sharing their experiences
- Be responsible for the quality of your volunteering and for yourself as part of a team
- Follow policies relevant to your role

- Events take place during weekends
