- Willing to speak to audiences in a variety of settings
- Willing to travel within the UK

- Deliver pre-prepared presentations effectively and as agreed by us
- Adapt your presentation delivery style to meet the needs of families
- Create an open environment where families have fair opportunities to contribute
- Answer questions that families may have about technology or signpost where appropriate
- Be responsible for the quality of your volunteering and for yourself as part of a team
- Follow policies relevant to your role
